



Westphal Continues Mastery of Infineon with Pole in Round 8

Sonoma, Calif. (July 6, 2008) – Jeff Westphal in his TNT Demolition/Cacci Construction PR1 Van Diemen continued his run of pole positions and will again start alongside Robert Podlesni for round 8 of the Pacific F2000 Championship presented by Hankook with a time of 1:33.424 two tenths off of his best time yesterday but maintained his advantage over Podlesni, driving his Terminal Velocity/Alpinestars DFR Van Diemen by .21 of a second.

Qualifying third fastest and also taking advantage of local knowledge was James Hakewill, 1:34.085 in his ARC International Van Diemen. Next to Hakewill will be PR1 Motorsports' Nick Freytag who qualified in the same spot yesterday and converted it into a podium finish in his Sodi Kart/GPhactory Van Diemen, 1:34.115.

The third row consists of a second DFR Van Diemen, the Silicon Salvage car of Chuck Hulse next to Shaun Modisette in the Carson Trailers, PR1 Van Diemen, Hulse at 1:34.288 and Modisette at 1:34.625.

Rounding out the top ten are Scott Rarick, Red Line Oil/Fast Forward Piper DF5, Max Hyatt, Energy Drink, PR1 Van Diemen, Peter Hastrup, Western Building Materials, DFR Van Diemen and Bob Negron, Fengshui 5/Negron Racing Van Diemen.

Others included Ira Fierberg, DFR Van Diemen, Bill Kincaid, Van Diemen, Les Phillips, Mygale, Chris Hundley, Van Diemen, Pierre Demartines, Fiorenzo Tirinnanzi, Van Diemen, Richard Lai Fatt, Mygale, and local National Driver Steve Filice, Tatuus.

Round seven is scheduled to take the green flag at 1:00 pm local time.
